

# **Feminist, Gender, & Sexuality Studies Program 2010-2011 Dissertation Fellowship**

Cornell University graduate students whose dissertation will focus on feminist, gender, and sexuality studies related issues are invited to apply for a fellowship to support their dissertation research. The fellowship will provide tuition, fees, health insurance, and a stipend for one semester during 2010-2011.

## **Eligibility**

Applications may be submitted by students from any major field. Preference will be given to those with a minor in FGSS, and to those who will use the grant while writing their dissertation. Applicants must be in their fourth year (or beyond) and have completed their A Exam by the beginning of the fellowship period.

## **Criteria**

Applications will be judged on the basis of:

- academic excellence of dissertation research
- strength of recommendations
- expected significance of research for FGSS scholarship across a range of disciplines

## **Applications**

Applications should include the following:

- Information Sheet with:
  - name
  - student ID number
  - net ID
  - major field
  - year of entry to Cornell
  - date of expected Ph.D.
  - special committee (specify chair and member, if any, representing the FGSS minor)
  - application date and signature
- Dissertation proposal of no more than 5 single-spaced pages, which includes a statement of the main objectives of the research and an indication of the progress to date
- Cornell transcript
- Statement about FGSS or related courses in which you are currently enrolled
- Summary of fellowship and other financial support to date
- Summary of fellowship and other financial support for 2010-2011
- Three letters of reference (one from chair of Special Committee, one from a member of the graduate field of FGSS who knows your work if chair is not in that field, and one or two from others.)

## **Deadline**

For review by the Graduate Affairs Committee of FGSS, applications must be submitted to Hope Mandeville, FGSS, 391 Uris Hall by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, March 12.
